

## **XtDisplayStringConversionWarning** – issue a conversion warning message

**void XtDisplayStringConversionWarning**(*display*, *from\_value*, *to\_type*)

**Display\*** *display*;

**String** *from\_value*, *to\_type*;

*display* Specifies the display connection with which the conversion is associated.

*from\_value* Specifies the string that could not be converted.

*to\_type* Specifies the target representation type requested.

The **XtDisplayStringConversionWarning** function issues a warning message using **XtAppWarningMsg** with name “conversionError”, type “string”, class “XtToolkitError”, and the default message string “Cannot convert “*from\_value*” to type “*to\_type*””.

To issue other types of warning or error messages, the type converter should use **XtAppWarningMsg** or **XtAppErrorMsg**.
