DRM-1804X Installing on Windows95

Microsoft's Windows 95 does not have direct support for Pioneer's DRM-1804X. To access the DRM1804X in the Windows 95 operating system, follow the instructions below:

- 1.) Add device driver to the CONFIG.SYS file: <ASPI Manager> C:\PIONEER\DRD18ASP.SYS /D:MSCD000
 - Note: <ASPI Manager> is dependent on the user's SCSI controller. Reference your SCSI controller manufacturer.
 - Example: Adaptec 1542CF SCSI controller: C:\ADAPTEC\ASP4DOS.SYS C:\PIONEER\DRD18ASP.SYS /D:MSCD000
 - Note: Future Domain SCSI controller will not need an ASPI manager
 - Example: Future Domain SCSI controller C:\PIONEER\DRD18FD.SYS /D:MSCD000
- 2.) Add latest MSCDEX to AUTOEXEC.BAT file:
 - Example:
 - C:\WINDOWS\COMMAND\MSCDEX.EXE /D:MSCD000
- 3.) Add "DRD18ASP.SYS" to the IOS.INI file.
 - a.) goto Windows directory
 - b.) copy IOS.INI file to IOS.ORG
 - c.) Edit IOS.INI file
 - d.) locate the section named "[CDunsafe]" near the bottom of the file.
 - e.) add "DRD18ASP.SYS" name under the "[CDunsafe]" section
 - i.e. [SafeList]

[CDunsafe] drd18asp.sys ; Pioneer 1804x

f.) exit IOS.INI and reboot the computer system
