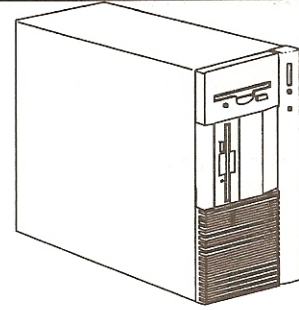


# AT&T Globalyst™ 590

The AT&T Globalyst™ 590 System is targeted at users seeking superb performance in a PC. This system has been extensively tested to fulfill the needs of professional accounts with mission critical applications and networked environments by the combining a choice of Intel Pentium 60 or 66MHz processor technology, high performance graphics, access to the emerging PCI bus standard and extensive expandability, all at an attractive price.

With the available business audio and CD-ROM features, the uses for the AT&T Globalyst™ 590 extend to Multimedia. This system is equipped with a software controlled power management solution. The AT&T Globalyst™ 590 has the capability to power-down the fixed disk drive and the monitor after a user-defined period of time providing optimal power savings.

The Globalyst™ 590 offers true PCI "plug and play" auto-configuration capabilities to save time and money. Additionally, this system supports PCMCIA technology that greatly facilitates data exchange via PC cards between portable systems and desktop personal computers. The Globalyst™ 590 will serve as your business partner, furnishing you with a multiplicity of usages, such as high performance Windows client, high performance OS/2 client, Desktop Publishing client, computer-aided design (CAD) workstation, and a small, basic high performance desktop server. Additionally, AT&T Vistium™ Share Software, currently available in the English language, is included on all U.S. and Canada Globalyst 590 Windows and Windows for Workgroups models allowing you to work collaboratively, share applications, and simultaneously modify files with other team members, associates, and business partners.

The AT&T Globalyst™ 590 is designed to compete against the Compaq DeskPro XL, the Dell OmniPlex, the IBM PS/Valuepoint, and the Hewlett Packard Vectra XP.

## System Features/Available Models:

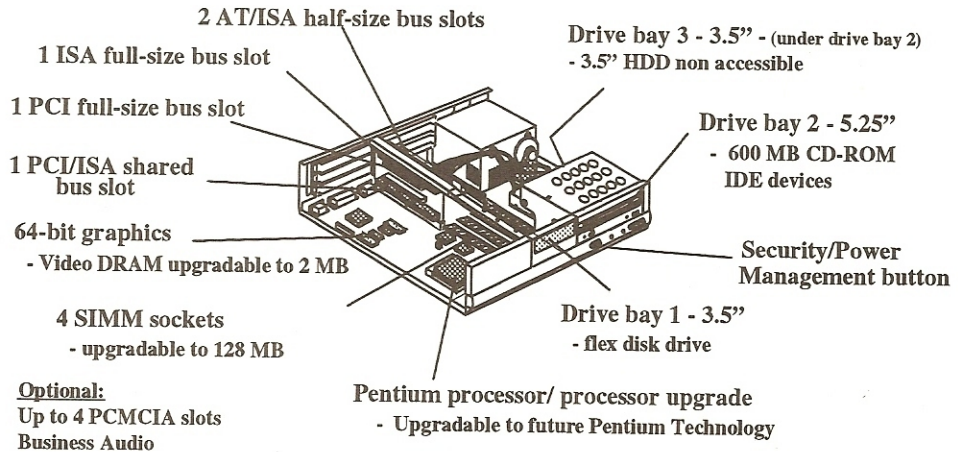
