Part 1. About the HDD option

You can increase your computer's storage with this HDD option. For details on how to replace this HDD option with your computer's hard disk drive, see the computer's user's reference.

- Handling the hard disk drive -
- Do not drop or apply any shock.

The drive is very sensitive. Incorrect handling can cause damage and permanent loss of data on the hard disk. Before removing the current hard disk drive, make a backup copy of all the information on the hard disk. Never remove the drive while the system is operating, in suspend mode, or in hibernation mode.
