

# **Important: Read First for users of DLA**

## Power Management

After writing to CD media using DLA, please wait 60 seconds before performing Hibernate/Suspend/Dock/Undock. This will ensure any data left in the cache is written to the CD media.

## Hot Swap/Warm Swap

Prior to performing Hot Swap/Warm Swap, remove the CD from the drive if you have written to it using DLA. This will ensure any data left in the cache is written to the CD media and avoid the possibility of data loss.

# For Windows 2000 Professional Users Only: Before Installing DLA

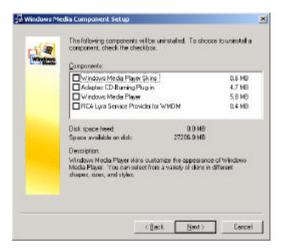
If your computer has Media Player v7 or v7.1 loaded with Microsoft® Windows® 2000 Professional, ensure the Adaptec CD-Burning Plug-in for Media Player v7 or v7.1 is removed *before* installing DLA. This plug-in may cause conflicts with your CD-RW application software. If you have already installed DLA, uninstall DLA and remove the Adaptec CD-Burning Plug-in before reinstalling DLA.

To remove the Adaptec CD-Burning Plug-in:

- 1. From the Windows desktop, click Start, Settings, and Control Panel.
- 2. Select Add/Remove Programs.
- 3. Select the Microsoft Media Player 7 or 7.1, then click **Remove**.

Note: Do not select "Allow removal of shared components"

4. From the list of displayed components, check the **Adaptec CD-Burning Plug-in**.



5. Click **Next** to remove the Plug-in.

Note: These steps will NOT remove the Microsoft Windows Media Player.
