Operating system support

The Adaptec Update 1.06 program for DirectCD Version 3.5c and EasyCD Creator Version 2.5d provided with this IBM[®] product supports the following operating systems.

- Microsoft® Windows® 95 OSR2
- Windows 98
- Microsoft Windows NT® 4.0 Workstation with Service Packs 4, 5, or 6A. Service Pack 6 is not supported.

Microsoft Windows 2000 Professional is not supported.

To run the Adaptec DirectCD/EasyCD Creator program, your computer must have a minimum of 32 MB of system memory.

To install your Adaptec software:

- 1. Insert the Adaptec CD into your CD-ROM drive.
- 2. Insert the Adaptec update diskette into your diskette drive.
- 3. The Installation Wizard opens. Follow the on-screen installation instructions. If the Installation Wizard does not start automatically, use Add/Remove Programs in the Control Panel Settings to install the software.
- When prompted for the Adaptec Update Diskette, make sure that you click Next to ensure proper installation of the updates. You must perform these steps for the installation of both EasyCD Creator and DirectCD.
 Note: Do not interrupt the installation of these updates. You must wait for each update to finish installing before performing any other tasks.

Limitations with IBM models PC 300GL and PC 300PL

If you have an IBM PC 300PL (type 6563, 6564, or 6574) or an IBM PC 300PL (type 6565) and you are having problems writing discs, you might need to download the latest version of the VIA AGP 4X/133 Bus Master IDE Driver, or disable the VIA AGP/133 bus master IDE drive and enable the ATAPI IDE Bus Master Driver.

To download the latest version of the VIA AGP 4X/133 Bus Master IDE Driver, go to the IBM PC Company Web site at: http://www.ibm.com/pc/support and search for VIA AGP.

To disable the VIA AGP/133 Bus Master IDE Driver and enable the ATAPI IDE Bus Master Driver, follow these instructions.

- 1. Log in as Administrator.
- 2. Click Start → Settings → Control Panel.
- 3. Double-click the **Devices** icon.
- 4. Scroll down and select Atapi.
- 5. Click Startup.
- 6. In the Device window, select Boot.
- 7. Click OK.
- 8. Scroll down and select Viadsk.
- 9. Click Startup.
- 10. In the Device window, select **Disabled**.
- 11. Click OK.
- 12. In the Device window, click Yes.
- 13. Double-check steps 1-12 above.
- 14. Restart your computer.

Corrections to the 8X/4X/32X Internal IDE CD-ReWritable Drive Option Kit

The instructions listed in the *User's Guide* must be amended as follows to match release 3.5C of DirectCD software/release 2.5D of EasyCD Creator software.

Step 9: The configuration-setup screen will be displayed only if you are adding new hardware. It will not appear if you replace an existing CD-ROM drive with the CD-RW drive.

Step 11: Steps 1 and 2 of the instructions to install the EasyCD Creator/DirectCD software for Windows 98, Windows 95, or Windows NT 4.0 should appear as follows:

- 1. Insert the EasyCD Creator/DirectCD disc into your CD-RW drive.
- 2. Insert the 8X/4X/32X CD Re-Writable Drive Option diskette into your diskette drive.
- 3. If the Adaptec installation window opens, select the software you wish to install: EasyCD Creator, DirectCD, or UDF Reader. Install UDF Reader last because it requires the computer to restart for installation to be complete.

If the Adaptec installation window does not open, continue to the next step.

Follow instructions 3 through 7 as they appear in your User's Guide.

In the section "Using the EasyCD Creator/DirectCD Programs," step 1 of **To open DirectCD**: should state: Click **Adaptec DirectCD**.

In the section "Formatting CDs," step 1 should be: Insert a blank disc (included) into the drive. The Adaptec Welcome window opens. Click the **DirectCD** icon to start the DirectCD Wizard.

Step 5 of the "Formatting CDs" section states: If you plan to use data compression software with this disc, click to check the box next to the message Enable compression on this disc.

This option does not exist in the present version of the Adaptec software.

In the section "Creating data CDs," step 1 should state: Start \rightarrow Programs \rightarrow Adaptec EasyCD Creator \rightarrow EasyCD Creator.

In the section "Creating audio CDs," step 1 should state: Start \rightarrow Programs \rightarrow Adaptec EasyCD Creator \rightarrow EasyCD Creator.

In the section "Making a jewel case insert," step 1 should state: Start \rightarrow Programs \rightarrow Adaptec EasyCD Creator \rightarrow EasyCD Creator.

In the section "Backing up a CD," step 1 should state: Start \rightarrow Programs \rightarrow Adaptec EasyCD Creator \rightarrow EasyCD Creator.
