安裝與使用手冊

本節提供產品說明、安裝指示以及如何使用與維護可讀寫 IBM 40X/12X/40X Max CD (CD-RW) 光碟機的指示。

簡介

本節說明本選用設備及其附隨的軟體。本節還含有您安裝選用設備之前必須知道的一些資訊。

產品說明

IBM 40X/12X/40X Max CD-RW 光碟機可讀寫 CD-RW 以及可燒錄 CD (CD-R) 光碟,也可以讀取大量壓製的 CD。使用此光碟機建立的 CD 和可讀取 CD-RW 光碟及其他媒體的 Multi-Read CD-ROM 與 DVD-ROM 光碟機,以及只可讀取 CD-R 光碟與 CD-ROM 光碟的舊型非 MR 光碟機相容。

此光碟機 CD-R 光碟的速度為標準 CD-ROM 速度的 40 倍,記錄資料的速率高達每秒 1 6000 KB。在這種速率,光碟機燒錄 80 分鐘的 CD-R 光碟約需四分鐘。光碟機以不同的速度燒錄 CD-RW 和 CD-R 光碟。此光碟機寫入高速 CD-RW 光碟時速度為標準 CD-ROM 速度的十二倍。記錄資料的速率高達每秒 1800 KB。在這種速率,光碟機燒錄 80 分鐘的 CD-RW 光碟約需七分半鐘。此光碟機讀取資料速度約爲標準 CD-ROM 速度的 40 倍或每秒達 6000 KB。

本光碟機使用 Mount Rainier 技術。Mount Rainier 是專為簡化 CD-RW 的使用性而制定的開放業界標準。優點包括背景格式化及光碟機執行實體錯誤管理。有關資訊,請跳至 www.mt-rainier.org。

CD-RW 光碟機只可安裝在使用整合式磁碟機電子 (IDE) 或擴充式 IDE (EIDE) 架構的電腦。

除了本手冊外,選用套件還包含:

- 一條 IDE 接線
- 使用手冊與軟體 CD

軟體說明

使用手冊與軟體 CD 含有下列軟體:

- IBM RecordNow:供您以各種方式燒錄 CD。您可以使用 CD 拷貝機功能來備份 CD,或從硬碟中的檔案建立資料 CD。您也可以用 MP3 檔或其他音樂 CD 建立音樂 CD。
- IBM Drive Letter Access (DLA): 您可以使用 DLA 以便用磁碟機代號存取 CD-RW 光碟機。您可以使用 Windows 指令行或使用拖放方法複製檔案到可燒錄媒體。
- UDF Reader:您可以使用 UDF Reader 在其他 PC 讀取您燒錄的 CD。
- StorageGuard:您可以使用這個程式來監控已經備份的資料量。此程式還提供從 Web 更新燒錄軟體的簡易方法。

開始之前

請先閱讀下列資訊再開始安裝。您必須完成下列步驟才能夠安裝光碟機。

- 1. 判斷要使用的 IDE 連接埠以及對應的配置設定。
- 2. 放置或變更光碟機上的配置跳接器(您可能要變更其他裝的配置跳接器)。
- 3. 安裝光碟機到光碟機槽。
- 4. 配置系統。
- 5. 安裝軟體。

如果您不了解這些程序或不確定可自行完成所有這些描述的程序,請要求合格的電腦 技術人員為您安裝 CD-RW 光碟機。

系統需求

在開始安裝光碟機之前,請先確定電腦符合下列系統需求。

- 微處理器最低需求:Intel® Pentium® 處理器(或等值處理器)
- RAM 最低需求: 32 MB²
- 可用的 IDE 連線。
- 可用的內部電源連接。
- 可用的 5.25 英吋光碟機槽
- 以下任一種作業系統:
 - Microsoft[®] Windows[®] Millennium Edition (Me)
 - Microsoft Windows 2000 Professional
 - Microsoft Windows XP

您必須備妥平頭或十字螺絲起子來完成安裝。您可能還必須參閱電腦附隨的說明文件。 請務必要備妥該說明文件。

搬動指示

安裝期間,請採取下列預防措施來保護您的 CD-RW 光碟機:

- 請小心搬動光碟機。光碟機掉落或震動可能會損壞光碟機機體中的元件。
- 將 CD-RW 光碟機存放在防靜電袋中,直到要開始安裝到電腦時才取出。請限制您的 移動。移動容易產生靜電。
- 不要強迫插入電源線。這樣做可能損壞接頭或光碟機。



產品外觀

以下章節說明 CD-RW 光碟機的正面與背面。

光碟機的正面

請參閱下列圖例來識別安裝指示中提及的零件。



註: 前方擋板的設計可能不同 (因供應商而不同)。

1 忙碌指示燈:這個指示燈會在光碟機讀取、寫入或顯示 CD 時亮起。


2 CD 托盤:請使用此托盤載入及卸載 CD。

3 手動退出孔:這個孔可在正常退出程序不作用時提供從光碟機取出 CD 的退出機制。

4 退出/載入按鈕:按下此按鈕時可開啟或關閉 CD 托盤。

安裝光碟機

要安裝光碟機到電腦,請執行下列步驟:

步驟 1. 打開電腦

要打開電腦,請執行下列步驟:

- 1. 關閉電腦以及所有附屬裝置的電源。
- 2. 拔下電腦以及所有附屬裝置的電源線。
- 3. 取下電腦的外殼。請參閱電腦的說明文件來取得如何取下外殼的指示。

步驟 2. 打開光碟機包裝

要打開光碟機包裝,請執行下列步驟:

- 1. 觸摸未上漆的金屬表面至少兩秒鐘,來釋放任何累積的靜電。請掃拿光碟機的包裝袋同時將包裝袋接觸未上漆的金屬表約兩秒鐘。
- 2. 從袋中取出光碟機。

如果您必須放下光碟機,請將防靜電袋放置在理平的表面,然後將光碟機含元件的面朝上的方式放置在防靜電袋上。


步驟 3. 選取 IDE 連接埠

較新型的電腦通常有兩個 IDE 連接埠。如果您有兩個 IDE 連接埠,請使用次要 IDE 連接埠來連接 CD-RW 光碟機。通常次要 IDE 連接埠和連到硬碟的主要 IDE 連接埠緊鄰。您選取的 IDE 連接埠以及選取的接線位置將決定您在對光碟機使用的配置跳接器設定。請參閱『步驟 4. 設定配置跳接器』來取得如何設定配置跳接器的指示。

- 如果您有兩個 IDE 連接埠,請使用附隨光碟機的 IDE 接線將 CD-RW 光碟機連到 次要 IDE 連接埠。如果 CD-RW 光碟機是次要 IDE 連接埠上唯一的裝置,您要使 用主要配置設定。如果次要連接埠上除了 CD-RW 光碟機之外還有其他裝置,您要使 用附屬配置設定。
- 如果您必須將 CD-RW 光碟機連到同一個 IDE 連接埠當作高速裝置如硬碟機,請對 CD-RW 光碟機使用附屬設定,而對高速裝置使用主要設定。在某些情況下,如果同一條接線上有其他裝置配置爲附屬,硬碟機可能需要「同時有主要與附屬」的設定。有關如何在其他裝置設定配置跳接器的進一步資訊,請參閱電腦或裝置附隨說明文件的相關章節。
- 有些非 IBM 電腦支援接線選取設定,裝置在接線上的位置將決定裝置為主要或附屬。 請參閱電腦附隨的說明文件來判斷您的電腦是否支援這種設定。

步驟 4. 設定配置跳接器

下列圖例顯示主要 1 設定、附屬 2 設定以及接線選取 3 設定。請在與您在步驟 3 選擇的設定對應的一對接腳插入跳接器來配置 CD-RW 光碟機。



- 如果您要將光碟機配置爲主要,請將跳接器設成主要 裝置設定。(這是光碟機出廠時的設定。)如果 IDE 連接埠上有第二個裝置,請檢查該裝置是否配置爲附屬。
- 如果您要將光碟機配置爲附屬,請將跳接器設成附屬 2 裝置設定。請檢查 IDE 連接埠上的其他裝置是否配置爲主要(或 master-with-slave-present)。
- 如果您要將光碟機配置爲接線選取,請將跳接器設成接線選取 3 裝置設定。如果IDE 連接埠上有其他裝置,請檢查該裝置是否也是配置爲接線選取。

步驟 5. 裝載光碟機到機槽


警告: 當您將螺絲直接拴入光碟機時,請務必要使用選用設備包裝中所附的裝載螺 絲。使用太長的螺絲可能會損壞磁帶機。

您可以將 CD-RW 光碟機水平或垂直安裝在電腦中。如果您垂直裝載光碟機,您必須先 固定放入的 CD, 然後才可以關閉光碟機托盤, 否則 CD-RW 光碟機可能無法正常讀取 CD。有關如何在垂直裝載的光碟機固定 CD,請參閱第8頁的『載入 CD』。

- 1. 將光碟機滑入機槽中。您的電腦安裝儲存裝置時可能需要特殊必要的程序。請參閱 閱電腦附隨的說明文件來取得進一步的指示。
- 2. 將光碟機槽螺絲孔對準光碟機體或裝載托架上的螺紋孔。請務必要使用光碟機附隨 的裝載螺絲。使用長度錯誤的螺絲可能會損壞光碟機。請輕推螺絲來檢查它們的位 置。通常每一邊各使用二個螺絲。
- 3. 先檢查是否對齊,然後再拴緊螺絲來固定磁碟機。請不要拴太緊。

步驟 6. 連接光碟機接線

連接接線至 CD-RW 光碟機如下:



- 1. 如果您要連接 CD-RW 光碟機至音效配接卡或或主機板上的音效能,請找出所附的 音訊線,同時判斷哪一種接線和音效配接卡上的 CD 音效輸入連接埠最匹配。請將 選用的音訊線一端連到 CD-RW 光碟機音效輸出接頭 11 ,以及將另一頭連到音效 配接卡 CD 音效輸入連接埠。請保存多餘的接線供以後其他的音效配接卡使用。
 - 註: 有些電腦的接頭較小,和所附的音訊線不相容。如果您的電腦屬於這種接頭, 您必須訂購新的音訊線。
- 2. 連接 40 接腳 IDE 接線接頭 2 至光碟機上的 IDE 接頭。請對齊接線,標示顏色 的邊要最接近電源線接頭 3 。如果沒有接線連到 IDE 連接埠或 IDE 接線上只有 一個裝置接頭時,請使用附有本選項的 IDE 接線。如果您使用隨附的 IDE 接線, 請將接線的一端連到主機板 IDE 連接埠或 IDE 配接卡,將 IDE 接線的另一端連到 CD-RW 光碟機。
- 3. 找出一個連到電腦電源的可用電源線。請將四個插腳的電源線 **3** 連到 CD-RW 光 碟機 DC 電源接頭。

步驟 7. 完成硬體安裝

要完成硬體安裝,請執行下列步驟:

- 1. 請確定光碟機裝載穩固以及接頭確實接妥。
- 2. 確定接線不要干擾電腦外殼以及不會組斷任何風扇葉片以及通風流路徑。

- 3. 重新安裝電腦外殼。
- 4. 重新連接所有裝置並檢查有無切斷連接的裝置如鍵盤、滑鼠及顯示器。
- 5. 連接所有電源線至電源插座。

步驟 8. 更新電腦配置

完成硬體安裝後,請重新啓動電腦。通常,當您打開電腦電源時,會顯示配置設定畫 面。如果您未看到這個畫面,請查閱電腦說明文件中與存取配置或設定公用程式相關 的資訊。

在大部份的 IBM 電腦要檢查配置資訊,請在螢幕右上角顯示 IBM 圖形時按 F1。檢查 完資訊後,請儲存變更並結束。

步驟 9. 安裝 CD-RW 光碟機軟體

使用手冊與軟體 CD 含有二個軟體應用程式,用於 CD-RW 光碟機的 CD 寫入功能:

- IBM RecordNow
- IBM Drive Letter Access (DLA)

還有二個其他應用程式在某些情況很有用。

- · UDF Reader
- · StorageGuard

有關這些應用程式的資訊,請參閱第1頁的『軟體說明』。

要安裝這些應用程式,請執行下列步驟:

- 1. 插入使用手冊與軟體 CD 到 CD-RW 光碟機中。
- 2. 如果 CD 自動啓動,請遵循螢幕上的指示執行。如果未自動啓動,請執行下列步驟:
 - a. 按一下開始->執行,接著輸入 e:\engage.bat,其中 e: 是 CD-ROM 光碟機的 磁碟機代號。
 - b. 按一下**確定**。
- 3. 選取您的語言。
- 4. 選取您要安裝的應用程式。
- 5. 遵循螢幕上的指示執行。

使用 CD-R 和 CD-RW 光碟

CD-RW 光碟機可寫入 CD-R 與 CD-RW 光碟。 CD-RW 光碟可抹除及重複使用多次, CD-R 光碟只可寫入一次。

附註:

- 1. CD-R 光碟可在音效光碟 CD 播放機播放。CD-RW 光碟只可在某些音效 CD 播放 機上播放。
- 2. CD-R 媒體是以燒錄速度分類。在 40x 寫入模式,必須使用 40x 媒體。爲取得最佳 效果,請將寫入速度限制在媒體速度分類內。選用設備套件中隨附的「Record Now Software」可限制燒錄速度上限。有閱詳細資訊,請跳至 第10頁的『限制燒錄速 度』。
- 3. CD-RW 媒體也是依燒錄速度分類。IBM 40X/12X/40X 光碟機只支援 4x 或以上的 CD-RW 光碟燒錄。燒錄速度上限將列印在媒體包裝或媒體光碟上。

使用光碟機

本節提供如何搬運與維護 CD 光碟以及 CD-RW 光碟機,以及如何載入 CD 到光碟機 的資訊。

搬運與維維護 CD

CD 是一種高密度媒體,必須小心搬運以及保持乾淨,才能夠正常讀取。這些預防措施 可協助延長 CD 的使用壽命。

警告: 沿著 CD 中心擦拭光碟可能會引起資料遺失。



- 請握拿 CD 的邊緣或中央的小孔。請不要觸摸 CD 的表面。
- 要除去灰塵或指紋,請使用柔軟沒有線絮的布從中心往邊緣方向擦拭。
- 不要在光碟表面寫字。
- · 不要讓太陽直射 CD。
- 不要使用市售清潔劑清潔 CD。
- 不要彎曲 CD。


維護 CD-RW 光碟機

要在作業期間護 CD-RW 光碟機,請採取下列預防措施:

- 搬動光碟機時,請取出光碟機中的 CD。
- 不要將異物插入光碟機中。
- 不要卸下光碟機外殼或企圖修理光碟機。
- 不要在下列任一種情況下操作光碟機:
 - 高溫、高濕度或陽光直射
 - 連續震動、突然震動或傾斜表面
 - 過多灰塵

載入 CD


要載入 CD 至水平裝載的 CD-RW 光碟機,請執行下列步驟: ...



- 1. 按退出/載入按鈕。托盤會滑出光碟機。
- 2. 插入 CD 至載入托盤。
- 3. 按退出/載入按鈕或輕輕推入托盤來載入托盤。

警告: 不要強迫打開托盤,也不要插入異物到 CD 托盤中。如果您按**退出/載入**按鈕時 托盤未開啓,請參閱第9頁的『手動退出 CD』。

要載入 CD 到垂直裝載的 CD-RW 光碟機,請執行下列步驟:




註: 光碟機 CD 托盤設計可能和所顯示的不同 (因供應商而不同)。

- 1. 按 退出/載入按鈕 1 。
- 2. 插入 CD 至托盤,同時確定光碟確實固定在垂直裝載卡栓後方。
- 3. 按退出/載入按鈕或輕輕推入托盤來載入托盤。

手動退出 CD

如果您按**退出/載入**按鈕時托盤未滑出,請關電腦的電源。如圖所示請拉直大別針來當 作工具。拉直後長度必須至少 45 公釐 (1.8 英吋)。將拉直的一端插入光碟機前面的手 動退出孔 (請參閱第3頁的『光碟機的正面』)。請將別針推入孔中,直到托盤打開爲止。 請輕輕拉出托盤,直到可取出 CD 爲止。



在 CD-RW 光碟機使用 Windows XP 内建的燒錄功能

本 CD-RW 光碟機和 Windows XP 內建的燒錄功能完全相容。如果使用 Windows XP, 您不需要額外的軟體便可以資料 CD。如果您安裝 CD-RW 光碟機附隨的 DLA 軟體, Windows 的內建燒錄功能會被關閉並由 DLA 執行格式化及燒錄功能。使用 Windows 內建燒錄功能建立的 CD 可被大多數的 Windows 讀取而不需要特殊的讀取程式。

要使用 Windows XP 內建燒錄功能複製檔案至 CD,請使用「檔案總管」將檔案拖曳至 光碟機代碼字母。Windows 會將檔案暫存至暫時位置。您備妥要寫入至 CD 後,請打 開光碟機代號字母,然後按一下寫入這些檔案至 CD。

註: 嘗試退出光碟片時,會提示您是否要燒錄檔案。

使用 IBM Drive Letter Access (DLA)

IBM Drive Letter Access (DLA) 附隨在使用手冊與軟體 CD 中,可用來寫入資料至 CD-RW 和 CD-R 媒體。

註: CD-RW 媒體可重複寫入多次,CD-R 媒體只可寫入一次。

The CD-RW drive uses the following methods to write files to CDs:

- Disc at Once: The drive writes to the entire disc in a single pass; data cannot be added at a later time.
- Track at Once: The drive copies one track at a time to the disc.
- Multisession: The drive writes several sessions to a disc; each session has at least one track.

Listed below are descriptions of different CD formats that appear in the table.

CD-Digital Audio: This format records audio CDs that can be played on audio CD players.

CD Extra: This format records audio and data in a multisession format.

CD TEXT: This format records audio CDs with the album names and song titles encoded.

CD-ROM (Mode 1): This format is used for most CD-ROM applications.

附錄B. Problem solving

Computer problems can be caused by hardware, software, or user error. You might be able to use the information in this section to solve problems yourself, or gather helpful information you can pass on to a service technician.

Review the following list for any problem descriptions that might fit your situation.

Troubleshooting

Your computer or CD-RW drive does not operate correctly or the busy indicator light does not come on.

Take the following actions:

- 1. Check that the CD is loaded with the label side up.
- 2. Check that all devices are correctly connected to the computer and the electrical outlet. If all devices are correctly connected and you are still experiencing problems, go to step 3.
- 3. Turn off the computer, unplug the cables from the electrical outlets for your computer and all attached devices, and remove the computer cover.
- 4. Check that all power and IDE cables are securely attached. Disconnect the IDE cable and check for bent or misaligned pins. If you do not find any problems, reconnect the IDE cable. Reattach all cables and power cords, and replace the computer cover. Turn on the computer, restart the system, and then attempt to open the CD tray by pressing the **Eject/Load** button. If the tray fails to open and the busy indicator light does not come on, turn off the computer and try using another 4-pin dc power cable.
- 5. Check that the color-coded edge on the IDE cable aligns with pin 1 on the IDE port and is closest to the power cable on the 40X/12X/40X Max CD-ReWritable drive See 第4頁的『步驟 3. 選取 IDE 連接埠』.
- 6. Check that the IDE cable is connected to the proper IDE port connection. See 第4 頁的『步驟 3. 選取 IDE 連接埠』 for more information.
- 7. Check the CD-RW drive and any other device on the IDE cable for the proper master/slave jumper settings. See 第4頁的『步驟 4. 設定配置跳接器』 for more information.
- 8. If the middle connector on the IDE cable is attached to the IDE port on the system board, remove the connector and reattach the cable. If there is only one device on the IDE port, attach the connector at one end of the cable to the IDE port and the connector at the other end to the device, leaving the middle connector (if there is one) open. If there are two devices on the IDE port, attach the connector at one end of the cable to the IDE port. If there is a hard disk drive, attach it to the connector at the other end of the cable and attach the CD-RW drive to the middle connector.

You cannot format a CD-RW disc

Take the following actions:

- 1. Check your media. This CD-RW drive cannot format 1X or 2X speed media.
- 2. Erase the CD-RW with the following procedure, then try formatting again.
 - · Remove all discs from drives.
 - · Start RecordNow.
 - · Select Make a Data Disc.
 - Insert your media when prompted.
 - At the prompt "The disc you have inserted is not blank, would you like to erase it now?", select Yes.
 - · After the media erase completes, Select the Cancel button in RecordNow
 - · Exit RecordNow.
 - Eject the media.
- 3. If you are using a third party bus-master driver, check with the driver manufacturer to ensure it supports CD-RW drives.

You cannot create a multi-session disc.

Be sure that there is enough space left on the media for another session. Writing a session requires about 15 MB in addition to the data that is recorded.

You cannot successfully write to a CD-R or CD-RW disc.

Take the following action:

- 1. Verify that the process is not being interrupted by a screen saver, an antivirus program, an Internet or e-mail program, or other software. Disable the functions that might interrupt the write operation.
- 2. Verify that your computer has the minimum processor listed in the system requirements for this option. See 第2頁的『系統需求』 for more information.
- 3. Verify that the hard disk drive has been defragmented.
- 4. Replace the disc if it is damaged or scratched.
- 5. Verify that the write-speed is correct for this disc.

You cannot eject a CD.

Take the following actions after ensuring that the drive is not in the process of writing:

- 1. Close all applications.
- 2. Eject the CD with the software application. Double-click My Computer. Click the CDR/RW icon. Click Eject.
- 3. Use the **Eject/Load** button.
- 4. Turn off the computer. Wait 45 seconds; then turn on the computer and try using the **Eject/Load** button again.
- 5. If other methods do not work, use the manual-eject hole, using instructions given in 第9頁的『手動退出 CD』.

You cannot read from the CD after successfully writing to it.

Take the following actions:

- 1. If you can read the CD in another CD player or you can see previous sessions, the directory information might be damaged on the volume, making it unreadable. Check the Veritas software online user's guide for more troubleshooting ideas.
- You might have a damaged CD-R or CD-RW disc. Try a new CD-R disc or CD-RW disc, or another brand of disc.
- 3. If you can read from a CD-RW disc in the CD-RW drive, but not in another optical drive, be sure that a UDF Reader program is installed on the computer that contains the other optical drive. For more information on the UDF Reader program, see 第10 頁的『在 Windows 98、Windows NT 4.0 或 Windows Me 使用 UDF Reader 軟體』.
- 4. Verify that you are not attempting to write the disc under extreme environmental conditions such as the following:
 - low temperature: 5° C (41° F) or below
 - high temperature: 45° C (113 °F) or above
 - excessive shock: >0.5 G
 - excessive vibration: >0.1 G
- 5. Make sure the CD-R session is closed. See 第10頁的『使用 RecordNow 軟體』 for help. A non-closed audio disc cannot be played in your car or home CD player.

You cannot access the CD-RW drive, or the drive icon does not display (Windows XP)

If the CD-RW drive has been properly installed, there will be an icon for the drive in the My Computer window. If you double-click the **My Computer** icon and there is no drive icon present in the displayed window, check to see that the drive has been properly installed, and that the configuration jumper has been correctly set. For more information, see 第4頁的『步驟 4. 設定配置跳接器』. Next, restart your computer. If a drive icon is still not found, continue with the following steps.

- 1. Click Start → Settings → Control Panel.
- 2. Click System.
- 3. Click the Device Manager tab.
- 4. Double-click View Devices by Type.
 - a. Click **Hard Disk Controllers** on the Device Manager list. Ensure that there are no conflicts with the controller. Ensure that the device status indicates that the controller is working properly.
 - b. Select CD-RW from the Device Manager list. Verify that there is a CD-RW device and that no conflicts exist. The device status will indicate that the device is working properly.
- 5. Click OK.
- 6. Restart the computer.

If the device icon is still not present, check cable connections, device jumper settings, and resolve any existing conflicts.

The CD cannot be read.

Take the following actions:

- 1. The CD might be dirty; clean it as described in 第7頁的『搬運與維維護 CD』.
- 2. The CD might be defective; try another CD.
- 3. The CD is not ISO-9660 or High Sierra Group-compatible. Check with your place of purchase.

There is no sound from the CD.

Take the following actions:

- 1. Check that you are using an audio CD and not a data CD.
- 2. Adjust the sound-adapter volume control. See the documentation that comes with your sound adapter and audio-CD player program.
- 3. Turn off the computer, unplug the cables from the electrical outlets for your computer and all attached devices, and remove the computer cover. Check that the audio-signal cable connects the 40X/12X/40X Max CD-RW drive to the sound adapter.

The connectors on the audio cables provided do not fit the connector on your audio adapter.

Some audio adapters might require a special cable. See the documentation that comes with your sound adapter.

You might have to purchase a separate audio cable for the 40X/12X/40X Max CD-RW drive. The audio-out connector on the 40X/12X/40X Max CD-RW drive requires a MPC-2 compliant Molex 70553 or equivalent connector. (To locate the drive audio connector, see 第3頁的『光碟機的背面』.) If you are using an IBM computer or IBM sound adapter, see 第23頁的『Service and Support』 for assistance.

You receive "buffer underrun" error messages when copying CDs or making data CDs.

Take the following actions:

- · If the file source is a network or removable device, copy the files to the local hard disk first.
- If using CD copier, select Advanced and check the Copy to Hard Disk option.
- · If using RecordNow, select Options->Advanced, and make sure that Burn-Proof is checked.
- Try reducing the write speed.
- Make sure the source and target drives are being operated in DMA mode. See 第21 頁的『附錄C. Customizing the device-driver configuration settings』 for more information.

Appendix C. Customizing the device-driver configuration settings

Windows XP and Window Me have two device-driver configuration parameters: Auto Insert Notify and DMA.

The Auto Insert Notify parameter enables the computer to start audio CD software as soon as a CD is inserted into the CD-RW drive.

The DMA parameter improves computer performance by having the computer DMA controller handle data transfers from the CD to memory, freeing the computer microprocessor to perform more important tasks. For example, activating DMA might make movies and games run more smoothly because the microprocessor is allocating more processing time to video.

Changing the Auto Insert Notify and DMA parameters for Windows Me

To change the Auto Insert Notify and DMA parameter settings in Windows Me do the following:

- 1. Click Start → Settings → Control Panel.
- 2. Click on view all control panel options.
- 3. Double-click System.
- 4. Click the **Device Manager** tab.
- 5. Double-click CD-ROM.
- 6. Click on the drive that you want to modify.
- 7. Click the **Settings** tab.
- 8. Click to select or to clear the **Auto Insert Notification** check box and the **DMA** check box, depending on which parameters you want to enable or disable.
- 9. Click OK.

Changing the DMA parameter setting from the Windows XP desktop

To change the DMA parameter setting from the Windows XP desktop do the following:

- 1. Click Start → Control Panel.
- 2. Click Switch to classic view.
- 3. Double-click System.
- 4. Click the Hardware tab.
- 5. Click Device Manager button.
- **6**. Click on the **IDE ATA/ATAPI controllers** to expand the tree.
- 7. Double-click on the controller that corresponds to where your CD-RW is located (**Primary IDE** or **Secondary IDE**).
- 8. Click the **Advanced Settings** tab.
- 9. Select the appropriate **Transfer Mode** pull-down that corresponds to the CD-RW location (**Device 0** for Master, **Device 1** for Slave).
- 10. Select DMA if Available.
- 11. Click OK.
