# **Part 1: Quick Installation Guide**

This guide contains installation instructions in an abbreviated form. If you are knowledgeable about SCSI products and experienced in installing options, use these instructions to quickly install your tape drive. For a description of the tape drive and more detailed installation instructions, go to "Part 2: User's Guide" on page 2-1.



#### **Installing the Drive Internally**

Follow these instructions to install the tape drive using a single-ended SCSI bus adapter.

- Turn off the computer and unplug the power cables from the power outlet for the computer and all attached peripherals.
- 2. Unlock the computer, if necessary, and remove the cover.
- Touch the static-protective bag containing the tape drive to an
  unpainted metal surface on the computer for at least 2 seconds.
   Remove the drive from the static-protective bag, holding the drive
  by the edges, and place it on the bag.
- Refer to the illustration below to locate the SCSI configuration block and to see how to set a jumper position to ON 1 or OFF
  - 2 . To set a jumper ON, make sure the jumper is covering both pins. To set a jumper OFF, you can either take the jumper off completely, or you can place the jumper over one of the pins; it doesn't matter which pin the jumper is covering. Placing the jumper over one of the pins ensures that you won't lose the jumper.

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The SCSI configuration block pin assignments are:

15 and 16: Enable terminator power

13 and 14: Enable termination

11 and 12: Reserved

9 and 10: Reserved

7 and 8: Enable parity

**5** and **6**: SCSI bit 2

3 and 4: SCSI bit 1

1 and 2: SCSI bit 0

5. Be sure the tape drive has a SCSI ID that is not being used by another device. The tape drive has a default setting of SCSI ID 0 when shipped. If you need to reset the SCSI ID, refer to the SCSI ID Pin Assignment table below for the ID jumper pin settings.

- 6. If the tape drive is the last device on the SCSI bus, the bus must be terminated. Some cables will provide self-termination. The tape drive is shipped with termination disabled; if you need to enable termination, place a jumper over pins 13 and 14.
- 7. Normally the SCSI bus adapter supplies terminator power. Therefore, the tape drive is shipped with **enable terminator power** OFF (terminator power disabled). If you need to enable terminator power, place a jumper over pins **15** and **16**.
- 8. The parity is set to ON, **enable parity**, as the default (jumper over pins **7** and **8**). To disable parity, set the jumper to OFF.
- 9. Locate an available bay or space in your computer to mount the tape drive. The drive can be mounted in either a horizontal or vertical position. The drive fits in a 3.5-inch (1-inch high) standard bay. You can also mount the drive in a 5.25-inch (1.6-inch high) bay using the 5.25-inch mounting kit provided.

The installation instructions are located on the mounting kit packaging.

The following table lists several IBM PC Servers, IntelliStation professional workstations, and desktop PCs, and gives the available bays for each model. Some servers and workstations may have a lockable door covering the drive bays. If you are installing the tape drive into one of these servers or workstations, you can use the included recess bezel kit to install the tape drive. With the recess bezel kit, the tape drive sits further back in the bay, so the tape cartridge does not stick out and keep the door from closing completely.

- 10. Remove the bay cover, if necessary. Slide the tape drive into the bay, and secure it with the mounting screws provided in the option package. Do not use any other screws to secure the **drive.** Using screws that are too long might damage the drive.
- 11. Locate the SCSI bus cable (usually a 50-pin ribbon cable) that is inside your computer, and attach one of the connectors on the cable to the tape drive. Ensure that pin 1 of the SCSI bus cable

(usually color coded) aligns with pin 1 of the SCSI connector on the tape drive. If your computer has a 68-pin cable, use the fast/wide-to-narrow SCSI internal converter included in the option package. The wide (68-pin) side of the adapter attaches to your computer's SCSI bus cable, and the narrow (50-pin) side of the adapter attaches to the SCSI connector on the tape drive. Make sure that pin 1 of the SCSI cable (usually color coded) aligns with pin 1 of the SCSI connector on the tape drive 2.

- 12. Locate an available power cable inside your computer, and connect it to the four-pin power connector on the tape drive.
- 13. Replace the computer cover, and secure it in place.
- 14. Reconnect the ac power cord and any other signal cables to the outside of your computer, and plug the power cord into an available power outlet. Turn on all attached devices; then turn on the computer.
- 15. The tape software CD contains a README.TXT file with software installation instructions. Review the README instructions, and then install the software. The CD also contains tape backup and restore applications for most operating systems.

#### Installing the Drive in an External Enclosure

The 10/20 GB NS Tape Drive can be installed in the IBM External Half High SCSI Storage Enclosure (IBM part number 02K4274), or another equivalent external enclosure. For detailed instructions on installing the tape drive into an external enclosure, see "Installing the SCSI Drive in an External Enclosure" on page 2-9.

# Part 2: User's Guide

# **Product Description**

The IBM 10/20 GB NS Tape Drive allows you to save and restore data files. The tape drive is available in an internal model only, although it can be used with most external SCSI enclosures, such as IBM part number 02K4274 or the equivalent. The tape drive has the following features:

#### Tape capacity

Provides capacity to 20 GB<sup>8</sup> per cartridge when using the NS 20 Tape Cartridges and the hardware compression features of the tape drive. The actual capacity per cartridge varies depending on various factors, which include the type of backup data, the data cartridge type, and the condition of the media.

#### High speed data transfer

Maximizes data transfer to 2 MB per second when using the hardware compression features of the drive. If your computer is not capable of supporting this data transfer rate, the drive will automatically adjust tape speed to maintain streaming.

#### Streaming-tape intelligence

Provides a continuous tape motion for an uninterrupted precisely coordinated flow of data to and from the tape cartridge. This *streaming* motion, combined with the *serpentine* recording method contributes to the increased storage capacity, efficiency, and speed of this cartridge technology.

#### Serpentine recording method

Uses the *serpentine* recording method, which decreases read time by reading or writing data in both the forward and reverse directions. With this method, the tape is not rewound at the end of a track. Instead, the drive heads are logically or mechanically switched to a different position on the tape and another track is written or read in the reverse direction. The individual tracks are sequential to minimize the amount of head motion as the heads change position for each track.

#### **Installation flexibility**

Installs in a 5.25-inch or 3.5-inch bay, or can be used with most external SCSI enclosures. Comes with a recess bezel kit, for installation in desktop computers,

servers, or workstations with lockable security doors. Can also be installed into a one-third height bay, using a special rail kit which can be purchased separately.

#### SCSI-2 interface compatibility

Supports the SCSI-2 interface standard, which provides additional device support and greatly improves the performance of the original SCSI interface.

#### **Backward compatibility**

Provides read compatibility with IBM TR4 tape options. Note: This drive does not provide read or write compatibility with any travan format except the TR4.

#### Tape software support

Supports most tape back-up applications and operating systems such as:

Microsoft Windows 3.1x Windows 95 Windows NT 3.51 or higher Novell NetWare 3.1x or 4.x IBM OS/2 3.0 or higher

The included CD contains installation and operating instructions for the back-up and restore applications. Choose the back-up and restore application that best suits your needs.

# Before You Begin

## Installing the Drive Internally

This section provides instructions for installing the tape drive in an internal bay.

#### Step 1. Preparing for Installation

- 1. Turn off the computer and unplug the power cables from the power outlet for the computer and all attached peripherals.
- 2. Unlock the computer, if necessary, and remove the cover. For specific information on removing your computer's cover, refer to the documentation that comes with your computer.
- 3. Touch the static-protective bag containing the tape drive to an unpainted metal surface on the computer for at least 2 seconds. Remove the drive from the static-protective bag, holding the drive by the edges, and place it on the bag.


#### Step 2. Configuring the SCSI Drive

Each device connected to the SCSI bus adapter must have its own unique SCSI ID. For most computers, you can press F1 during startup to view your computer and SCSI bus adapter configuration. This information might include which SCSI IDs are currently in use. Some SCSI adapters have utility programs that allow you to view the SCSI configuration, or you might have to physically inspect the installed SCSI devices to see how the IDs are set. The tape drive is preset at the factory to SCSI ID 0. If your computer has another device which is using that ID, you will need to reset the SCSI ID. The ID you choose determines the priority of the device. In general, a low- or mid-priority device is given a lower ID, and a high-priority device is given a higher ID. Tape drives are usually considered slow or low-priority devices, so choose a lower SCSI ID for this drive. Do not assign the tape drive an ID of 7, because most SCSI bus adapters use that ID. Choose an ID from 1 to 6 for the tape drive. For more information, refer to the documentation that comes with your computer or SCSI bus adapter.

If you have determined that you need to reset the tape drive to another SCSI ID, and have chosen the ID which is appropriate for your needs, follow these steps to reset the SCSI ID.

- 1. Refer to the illustration below to locate the SCSI configuration block and to see how to set a jumper position to ON 1 or OFF
  - 2. To set a jumper ON, make sure the jumper is covering both pins. To set a jumper OFF, you can either take the jumper off completely, or you can place the jumper over one of the pins; it doesn't matter which pin the jumper is covering. Placing the

jumper over one of the pins ensures that you won't lose the jumper.



The SCSI configuration block pin assignments are:

15 and 16: Enable terminator power

13 and 14: Enable termination

11 and 12: Reserved

9 and 10: Reserved

7 and 8: Enable parity

**5** and **6**: SCSI bit 2

**3** and **4**: SCSI bit 1

1 and 2: SCSI bit 0

2. Be sure the tape drive has a SCSI ID that is not being used by another device. Refer to the SCSI ID Pin Assignment table below for the ID jumper pin settings. Then set the jumpers on the pins which match the ID you have chosen.

#### Step 3. Mounting the Drive

1. Locate an available bay or space in your computer to mount the tape drive. The drive can be mounted in either a horizontal or vertical position. The drive fits in a 3.5-inch (1-inch high) standard bay. You can also mount the drive in a 5.25-inch (1.6-inch high) bay using the 5.25-inch mounting kit provided. When you attach the brackets to the sides of the 3.5-inch tape drive, you increase the width and height of the drive. The instructions for using the 5.25-inch mounting kit are located on its packaging. Use only those parts necessary for your particular installation; some parts may not be required.

The following table lists several IBM PC Servers, IntelliStation professional workstations, and desktop PCs, and gives the available bays for each model. Some servers and workstations may have a lockable door covering the drive bays. If you are installing the tape drive into one of these servers or workstations, you can use the included recess bezel kit to install the tape drive. With the recess bezel kit, the tape drive sits further back in the bay, so the tape cartridge does not stick out and keep the door from closing completely.


- 2. Remove the cover plate from the bay selected. Slide the drive partially into the bay. Align the drive-bay screw holes with the threaded holes in the drive housing (or bracket, if applicable).
- 3. Use the screws provided to secure the drive in the bay. Using the wrong size screws can damage the drive. Usually two screws are used on each side. Some installations use the screw holes on the bottom (circuit board side) of the drive. Do not

overtighten the screws. Make sure that the drive is securely mounted.

#### Step 4. Attaching the SCSI and Power Cables

1. Locate the SCSI 1 and power 3 connectors using the illustration below.



- SCSI connector 1
- SCSI connector pin 1 2
- 3 Power connector
- 2. Locate the SCSI bus cable (usually a 50-pin ribbon cable) that is inside your computer. The SCSI bus adapter might already be on the computer system board, or it might be installed in an expansion slot. There can be up to seven connectors on the cable from the SCSI bus adapter. Locate an available SCSI connector on the SCSI bus cable, and attach it to the SCSI connector on the tape drive 1. If your computer has a 68-pin cable, use the fast/wide-to-narrow SCSI internal converter included in the option package. This has a 68-pin connector on one side, and a 50-pin connector on the other. Attach the 68-pin side to your

- computer's SCSI cable, and attach the 50-pin side to the SCSI connector on the tape drive. Make sure that pin 1 of the SCSI cable (usually color coded) aligns with pin 1 of the SCSI connector on the tape drive 2.
- 3. Locate an available power cable inside your computer, and connect it to the four-pin power connector on the tape drive.

The power cable connector is keyed and will fit easily only one way. Do not force it. If it does not attach easily, turn the connector around and try it again. If all power cables are in use, you can purchase a dc Y-connector at most electronics stores, which will split a connection to make room for more devices.

#### Step 5. Completing the Installation

Check your work before closing the computer.

- 1. Be sure that the power and interface connectors are securely
- Be sure that the cables are neatly routed. They must not: Get in the way when the cover is replaced. Impede the power supply fan blade. Block air flow paths.
- 3. Replace the computer cover and secure it in place.
- Reconnect the ac power cord and cables. Turn on all attached devices; then turn on the computer.

#### Step 6. Installing the Software

The tape software CD contains a README.TXT file with installation instructions. Review the README instructions before completing the software installation. The CD contains installation, tape back-up and restore applications for most operating systems such as:

Microsoft Windows 3.1x Windows 95 Windows NT 3.51 or higher Novell NetWare 3.1x or 4.x IBM OS/2 3.0 or higher

## Installing the SCSI Drive in an External Enclosure

The instructions in this section are for installing the 10/20 GB NS Tape Drive into the Options by IBM External Half High SCSI Storage Enclosure (IBM part number 02K4274). For instructions on installing the tape drive into other SCSI external enclosures, consult the documentation that comes with your enclosure.

#### Step 1. Preparing for Installation

- 1. Turn off the computer and unplug all power cables from the computer and all attached peripherals.
- 2. Touch the static-protective bag containing the tape drive to an unpainted metal surface on the computer for at least 2 seconds. Remove the drive from the static-protective bag, holding the drive by the edges, and place it in a convenient space next to your computer.

#### Step 2. Configuring the SCSI Drive

Each device connected to the SCSI bus adapter must have its own unique SCSI ID. For most computers, you can press F1 during startup to view your computer and SCSI bus adapter configuration. This information might include which SCSI IDs are currently in use. Some SCSI adapters have utility programs that allow you to view the SCSI configuration, or you might have to physically inspect the installed SCSI devices to see how the IDs are set. The tape drive is preset at the factory to SCSI ID 0. If your computer has another device which is using that ID, you will need to reset the SCSI ID. The ID you choose determines the priority of the device. In general, a low- or mid-priority device is given a lower ID, and a high-priority device is given a higher ID. Tape drives are usually considered slow or low-priority devices, so choose a lower SCSI ID for this drive. Do not assign the tape drive an ID of 7, because most SCSI bus adapters use that ID. Choose an ID from 1 to 6 for the tape drive.

The External Half High SCSI Storage Enclosure has a small cable which connects the jumpers for the tape drive to the SCSI ID setting switch on the rear of the enclosure. Refer to the documentation which comes with the external enclosure for more information on connecting this cable. If you are installing the tape drive into another type of external enclosure, refer to the documentation which came with that enclosure for more instructions.

#### Step 3. Installing the Drive into the Enclosure

Follow these instructions to install the tape drive:

- Refer to the documentation for the external enclosure for instructions on opening the enclosure and removing the front cover and filler panel. Once you have removed the filler panel, replace the front cover according to the instructions in the documentation for the enclosure.
- 2. You will need to attach the 5.25 inch bezel included with the tape drive in order to install it in the external enclosure. Refer to the documentation for the external enclosure, and follow the instructions for installing a 5.25 inch front loading drive.
- 3. When the instructions refer to the two types of standoff screws, locate the metric threaded standoffs. You need to use the metric standoffs with the tape drive. Once you have attached the standoffs to the tape drive, use the screws provided with the enclosure to secure the tape drive inside the enclosure.
- 4. The external enclosure comes with both a 50-pin internal cable and a 68-pin internal cable. Make sure the enclosure has the 50-pin cable attached; if necessary, change the cable. Plug the connector for the internal cable into the SCSI connector at the rear of the drive.
- 5. Attach the SCSI ID select cable as instructed in the documentation for the external enclosure.
- Attach the enclosure's power supply cable to the power connector on the drive.

- Once all the internal cables are connected to the tape drive, replace the cover of the enclosure and secure it with the appropriate screws.
- 8. If the tape drive is the last device on the SCSI chain, refer to the external enclosure documentation for instructions on termination.
- Refer to the external enclosure documentation for instructions on setting the SCSI ID setting switch.

#### Step 4. Completing the Installation

- Use a 50-pin SCSI cable to connect the enclosure to your computer.
- 2. Connect a power cable to the rear of the enclosure, and then plug the cable into a power outlet. Turn the power switch ON. (The power switch is on the rear panel of the enclosure.) Turn on the other attached devices; then turn on the computer.

#### Step 5. Installing the Software

The tape software CD contains a README.TXT file with installation instructions. Review the README instructions before completing the software installation. The CD contains installation, tape back-up and restore applications for most operating systems such as:



## Using the Tape Drive

This section provides information on using the features of the tape drive.

#### **Loading and Unloading Tape Cartridges**

The illustration shows the front panel of the tape drive.




The front panel of the tape drive contains the cartridge opening and one round, green light 1. This green light indicates drive activity. When the green light is OFF, the drive is not active.


Your tape drive has a flip-up door that covers the cartridge opening when you do not have a tape cartridge in the drive. Once you insert a cartridge, the tape drive holds it in place using a positive locking mechanism.

**Note:** Do not remove the tape cartridge while the drive is operating. Complete any tape operation and wait until the green activity light is OFF before removing the cartridge.

To load a cartridge, insert it with the metal base plate down and the tape access door facing the drive. The following illustration shows loading of a cartridge.




To unload a cartridge, wait until the drive activity light is OFF and then pull the cartridge straight out. The following figure illustrates unloading a cartridge.




#### **Setting the Write-Protect Switch**

Tape cartridges feature a write-protect switch located in the upper-left corner of the cartridge. You can set the switch to keep data from being written on the tape. Use this switch when you want to make sure that important data on the tape will not be overwritten.

The illustration below shows the cartridge with the switch 1 in the nonprotected (read and write) or unlocked position.



The following illustration shows the switch 2 in the protected (read only) or locked position.



To return a cartridge to the unprotected write state, push the switch towards the end of the cartridge or unlocked position.

#### **Improving Performance**

The 10/20 GB NS Tape Drive is ideally suited to streaming operations, as opposed to multiple-start-and-stop tape movement. Frequent start-and-stop operations are often the result of data underruns. Start-and-stop operation can also increase the stress on both the drive and the media.

If you are experiencing multiple starts-and-stops, or if you want to improve the tape drive's performance, try one of the following:

Shut down all nonessential applications.

Clean the drive's tape heads, using an appropriate tape-cleaning

Replace the data cartridge; it might be damaged or faulty.

### Maintenance

You need to perform minimal maintenance to ensure that your tape drive operates in peak condition. This section explains how to care for the tape cartridges and how to clean the drive head.

#### **Caring for Tape Cartridges**

The following points are guidelines for storing and using the cartridges:

Do not open the tape access door of the cartridge or touch the tape itself.

Keep cartridges away from sources of electromagnetic fields, such as telephones, dictation equipment, mechanical or printing calculators, motors, and bulk erasers. Do not place the cartridges on the computer monitor or on the base unit of the computer.

Keep cartridges away from direct sunlight and heat sources, such as radiators or warm air ducts.

Keep cartridges free of moisture. Do not wet or submerge cartridges in any liquid.

Do not expose cartridges to temperature extremes.

Re-tension tape cartridges that have not been used for more than a month before restoring or backing up data. Re-tensioning is the winding and rewinding of a tape cartridge. This action restores the proper tape tension to the media. The backup application software provides a function to re-tension a tape cartridge.


### **Cleaning the Tape Head**

To properly maintain the drive, periodically clean the tape head. You do not need to perform any other periodic maintenance. Clean the tape head once a week with a dry-process cleaning cartridge, such as IBM part number 16G8583. Follow the instructions which come with the cleaning cartridge.

Once the cleaning cartridge is inserted into the tape drive, the cleaning process is automatic. The entire process takes only a few seconds and is completed when the drive's activity light stops flashing. The cleaning cartridge is good for 30 cleaning operations.

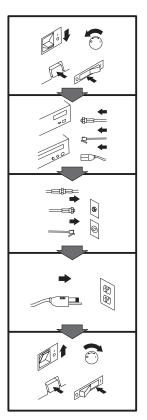
