#### **Safety Notices**

Observe the following safety instructions any time you are connecting or disconnecting devices attached to the system unit.

#### **DANGER**

An electrical outlet that is not correctly wired could place hazardous voltage on metal parts of the system or the devices that attach to the system. It is the responsibility of the customer to ensure that the outlet is correctly wired and grounded to prevent an electrical shock.

This unit has more than one power cord. To reduce the risk of electrical shock, disconnect two power supply cords before servicing.

### **Chapter 1. Overview**

Before performing the following procedures, locate the system unit's installation guide that was shipped with your system drawer. Turn to Chapter 3. "Installing Options". When you are asked to remove a part from the system drawer, locate that part's removal and replacement procedure in the system unit's installation guide and familiarize yourself with each step.


The system to rack stabilizing kit is used in locations that are susceptible to severe shaking and vibration. In this type of environment, the rack should be bolted to the floor.

The following items should have been packed with your system to rack stabilizing kit:





### Chapter 2. System to Rack Stabilizing Kit Installation


To install the system to rack stabilizing kit, perform the following four procedures. Note that each procedure is labeled as a step and that each step contains substeps. Complete each step (procedure) before going on to the next step.

#### Step 1. Install the Rear Stabilizing Pads

Position yourself in front of your rack and do the following:


- 1. Open the front rack door.
- 2. If installed, remove the two thumbscrews located just below the release latches. See the following illustration.

**Note:** Your system drawer has two distinct front bezel designs. On one of the bezels, the thumbscrews are mounted through holes located on each side of the bezel. The bezel is then secured to the system drawer and rack. With the other bezel design, the thumbscrews are mounted directly through slots located just below the release latch and secure only the system drawer to the rack.



- 1 Release Latch
- 2 Thumbscrew (quantity 2)
- 3 Front Bezel
- 3. Remove the front bezel, as described in "Front Bezel Removal".
- 4. Place the system drawer into the service position, as described in "Placing the Drawer in the Service Position".

Mount the two large support pads to each side of the system drawer using two M4 hex head screws. The threaded mounting holes are located on each side and one inch in from the rear edge of the system drawer. See the following illustration for the mounting location.




- 1 Rear Stabilizing Bracket Support Pad (quantity 2)
- 2 M4 Hex Head Screws (quantity 4)

#### Step 2: Mount the CEC Cover Card Supports

To install the CEC cover card supports, do the following:

- 1. Continue with the system drawer in the service position.
- 2. Remove the main chassis cover, as described in "Main Chassis Cover Removal".
- 3. Remove the media bay tray, CD-ROM or tape drive, as described in "Media Bay Tray Removal".
- 4. If installed, remove the power and signal cables from the rear of the media device, and place your media device in a safe place.
- 5. Remove the CEC box cover, as described in "CEC Box Cover Removal".
- 6. Position the CEC cover, as shown in the following illustration.




- 1 CEC Cover Card Supports (quantity 2)
- 2 M4 Pan Head Screws (quantity 4)
- Position the supports as shown, securing each support into position with two M4 pan head screws.
- 8. Replace the CEC cover, as described in "CEC Box Cover Replacement".

#### Step 3. Install the Rear Stabilizing Bracket


Position yourself at the rear of your rack and do the following:

- 1. Open the rear rack door.
- 2. Remove the two M5 hex head screws that secure the cable management arm to the adjustment plate.




- 1 Cable Management Arm Hinged Mounting Plate
- 2 M5 Hex Head Screws (quantity 2)
- 3 Cable Management Arm
- 3. Swing the cable management arm and connected cables out of the way.
- 4. Note the location of the adjustment plate and its two M5 hex head screws, and then remove them from the rack.

5. Remove the cable management arm adjustment plate.




- 1 Cable Management Arm Adjusting Plate
- 2 M5 Hex Head Screws (quantity 2)
- 3 Cable Management Arm
- 4 Cable Management Arm Hinged Mounting Plate
- 6. Mount the grounding plate to the rear of the chassis using the two M3.5 hex head screws. See the following illustration for mounting location.




1 Mounted Grounding Plate

Align the right side of the rear stabilizing bracket with the rack location of the removed adjustment plate.



- 1 Cable Management Arm Adjusting Bracket
- 2 M5 Hex Head Screws (quantity 4)
- 3 M3.5 Hex Head Screws (quantity 2)
- 4 System Drawer Ground Plate
- 8. Secure the rear stabilizing bracket to the rack using four M5 hex head screws. Ensure that the bracket is level before tightening the screws.
- 9. Using the two M5 hex head screws removed from the cable management arm adjustment plate in substep 2, secure the cable management arm to the side of the installed rear stabilizing bracket. See the following illustration for screw hole

#### locations.




- 1 Rear Stabilizing Bracket

- 3 M5 Hex Head Screws (quantity 2)
- 4 Cable Management Arm Hinged Mounting Plate
- 10. Close the rear rack door.

#### Step 4. Complete the Installation

Go to the front of the system drawer and do the following:

- 1. Push system drawer into the rack
- Align the slotted holes of the front support brackets to the mounting holes located on the rack. Mount a nut clip onto the aligned rack holes. See the following illustration.



1 Thumbscrew (quantity 2)

- 3. Return the system drawer to the operating position, as described in "Returning the Drawer to the Operating Position".
- 4. Insert the two thumbscrews, removed earlier in Step 1. If your system did not have thumbscrews securing the system drawer to the rack, locate them in your "Latch Bracket Mounting Kit" and install them at this time. See "Chapter 1. Installing" in your system unit's installation guide for a description of the latch bracket mounting kit.
- 5. Close the front rack door.


