The Enhanced 2.88MB (MB = 1 000 000 bytes) Diskette Drive is a 3.5-inch drive with the following features:

- Electrical diskette eject
- Security eject override
- Supports software eject commands
- Supports DOS, OS/2, and other operating systems

Security Mode Switch

2.0 Security Mode Switch

The Security Mode Switch is located on the right, rear corner of the hard disk drive. The switch settings are as follows:

- 1 Software eject and security eject override enabled
- 0 Software eject and security eject override disabled
